



Install JDK 1.8



- 1) Open the following site from your browser:
<https://www.oracle.com/java/technologies/javase/javase-jdk8-downloads.html>
- 2) Select the version of JDK installer you want as below:


- 3) You might need to sign-on to download. If you don't have an account, please register one before download.
- 4) After downloading completed, double-click the downloaded installer to run the installation:





- 5) Open command prompt from Window Start Button, type the following command:

java -version
